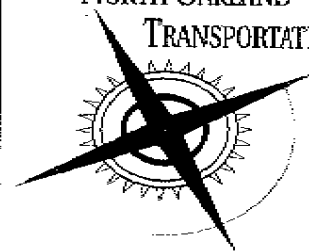

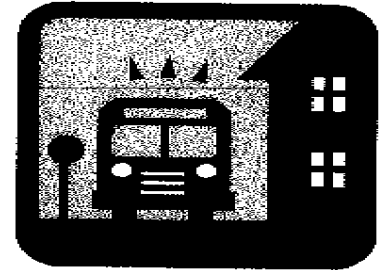

# NOTA ... On the Move



The North Oakland Transportation Authority is comprised of six (6) municipalities in northeast Oakland County. These communities, Orion, Oxford and Addison Townships and the Villages of Lake Orion, Oxford and Leonard have historically been underserved by the regions public transportation authority, SMART. This has been primarily due to our remoteness to Oakland County's population centers. The only service that existed prior to the creation of grass-roots advocacy and coalition-building, was a program initiated in Oxford and Addison townships that operated one (1) vehicle.

In 2001, Oxford, Orion and Addison residents formed the North Oakland Transportation Authority (N. O. T. A).

We are moving rapidly to keep up with demand. In 2010, N.O.T.A. provided 40,307 rides traveling 464,672 miles with expanded service hours.

## Transportation for Our Citizens

N. O. T. A. is a FREE SERVICE to Oxford, Orion and Addison residents for their transportation needs. Ridership is subject to qualification and after a short interview, we can set up a ridership program for you. We transport senior citizens, mentally & physically handicapped, developmentally disabled, transit dependent and Welfare to Work clients. NOTA has become the sole source of transportation for a substantial number of persons and we have proven we can do so efficiently and effectively.

The service area for N.O.T.A. encompasses 165 square miles into three different counties including Royal Oak Beaumont, Troy Beaumont, Rochester Crittenton, Lapeer General and St. Joe's Pontiac Hospitals.

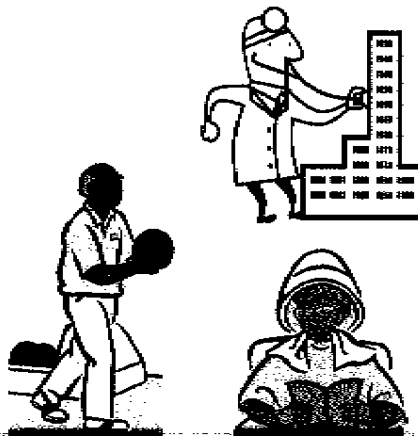
## User Friendly

We operate (7) days a week, thirteen hours a day, using sixteen (16) vehicles, thirteen (13) of which are equipped with wheelchair lifts.

N. O. T. A. is currently funded through grants and allocations of Community Development Block Grant funds through it's six (6) municipalities as well as federal grants, funding from TTI, Crittenton and Beaumont Hospitals and donations. We are constantly pursuing new sources of grants and funding.
