

## **NOTA Boundaries:**

All service within Orion, Oxford and Addison Townships cost \$1/each way. Service outside of the townships cost \$2/each way.

NOTA's Boundaries are as follows:

North—Davison Lake Road

East—Van Dyke Road

West —M-15/Dixie Hwy/Telegraph

South—Square Lake Road

The service area for N.O.T.A. encompasses 165 square miles into three different counties including Troy, Beaumont, Rochester, Crittenton and St. Joe's Pontiac Hospitals.

## **Application Process:**

Go to website: [www.notaride.org](http://www.notaride.org), come into office or call to have an application sent to you.

Return the application with a copy of drivers license or proof of residency.

If you are disabled, a professional verification form must be filled out by a doctor.

Application process usually takes 3-5 days

NOTA is a door to door demand response transportation service serving seniors, disabled and low income residents of Oxford, Orion and Addison Townships and the Villages of Oxford, Orion and Leonard since 2001. NOTA operates 14 routes Monday to Friday and two buses Saturday and Sunday.

In 2016, NOTA drove 436,000 miles and provided 33,879 rides to elderly, disabled and low income residents. The residents NOTA serves are transit dependent individuals who need help getting to medical appointments, grocery shopping, community events and work. Without NOTA many riders would not be able to leave their homes or live an independent life.

To apply you must be a resident of Orion, Oxford or Addison Townships and be at least age 60, disabled or low income. Once registered you can make your scheduled rides with at least 3 day advance notice. Please cancel appointments no later than 6 hours prior to appointment time.



## Transportation for Our Citizens

N. O. T. A. is a service to Oxford, Orion and Addison residents for their transportation needs. Ridership is subject to qualification. Please see our website [notaride.org](http://notaride.org) for an application or come into our office at 467 E. Jackson St. Lake Orion. After you have filled out the paperwork we can set up a ridership program for you. We transport senior citizens, disabled, and low income clients. NOTA has become the sole source of transportation for a substantial number of persons and we have proven we can do so efficiently and effectively.

## User Friendly

We operate seven days a week and have 20 vehicles and 16 are wheelchair equipped.

## Fare System

\$1 for all one way rides to Orion, Oxford and Addison Twp. \$2 for all other one way rides in our service area. Exact fare only or tokens. Tokens are available for purchase at our office. Buy 10 tokens get one free.
